ARTICLE 9: Shall the Town vote to exempt from taxes, for a period of five years, the property located at 241 Garvin Hill Road (Eshqua Bog) which is owned by the Nature Conservancy and the New England Wildflower Association and is used exclusively for the purpose of such organizations?
